The WMMH Co-op is the heart of that mission: a two-day-a-week, project-based program where students learn alongside other homeschoolers, work with real entrepreneurs, and present their work at the History Makers Expo.

GRADES 3 - 5

Explorer

First-money skills, saving habits, and "what could I make and sell?" thinking. Hands-on, game-driven, parent-friendly.

GRADES 6 - 8

Builder

Earning, budgeting, and building real micro-businesses. Students design products, brand them, and pitch to peers.

GRADES 9 - 12

Legacy

Financial planning, real business launches, leadership development. Mentorship from working Florida entrepreneurs.

1. Financial Literacy

Earning, saving, spending, budgeting, and responsible decision-making – taught with real dollars and real choices.

2. Entrepreneurship

Problem-finding, idea generation, product design, branding, marketing, and pitching – ending with a real micro-business.

3. Leadership Development

Communication, teamwork, goal-setting, and character. Public speaking and service-learning baked into every term.

4. Personal Growth

Identifying strengths, interests, and future direction. Vision boards, leadership journals, and career exploration.
